CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that THOMAS F. CARTER,
of 1148 CURRY ROAD, ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470, has a right to the use of
the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the
purpose of IRRIGATING 7.6 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 20663. The date of priority
is AUGUST 20, 1951. The right is limited to not more than 0.095 CUBIC
FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION; LOT
9 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 33, T 26 S, R 6 W, WM; 525 FEET NORTH &
1025 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER OF SECTION 33 or its equivalent in case
of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW1/4 SW1/4, SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE
6 WEST, WM; 550 FEET NORTH & 930 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount
secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be
limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its
equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a
diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre
irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such
right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.5 ACRES LOT 9 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4)
1.1 ACRES LOT 13 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4)
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted
to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and
point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources
Director entered July 20, 1983, and together with certificate 51965,
supersedes certificate, 21315 State Record of Water Right
Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the
status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610
pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water
Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
