CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that MR. AND MRS. BASCUM T. PAGE,
of 260 SE PINE, ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470, has a right to the use of the
waters of A SPRING AND LITTLE RIVER, TRIBUTARY OF NORTH UMPQUA RIVER,
for the purpose of STOCK USE AND IRRIGATING 2.3 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 26262. The date of priority
is JULY 9, 1959. The right is limited to not more than 0.035 CUBIC
FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.005 CFS FROM SPRING FOR STOCK USE AND 0.03
CFS FROM LITTLE RIVER FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of
rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE1/4 SW1/4, SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 3
WEST, WM; SPRING - 850 FEET NORTH & 250 FEET WEST; RIVER - 810 FEET
NORTH & 870 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM SE CORNER OF NE1/4 SW1/4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount
secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be
limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its
equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a
diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre
irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further
that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the
flow of water in the North Umpqua River is 525 cfs or more at its
mouth.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such
right is appurtenant, is as follows:

STOCK & 2.3 ACRES NE1/4 SW1/4
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE AND PLACE OF USE
approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER
29, 1978, and supersedes certificate 31850, State Record of Water
Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the
status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610
pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted
to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right
is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources
Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
