CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that GLENN DAMEWOOD, of 5598 EVANS VALLEY LOOP, SILVERTON, OREGON 97381, has a right to the use of the waters of UNNAMED SPRING, UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2160, TRIBUTARY OF ABIQUA CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATING 0.1 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 25657. The date of priority is JULY 29, 1958. The right is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.01 CFS FROM STREAM AND RESERVOIR FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.01 CFS FROM SPRING FOR DOMESTIC USE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN LANGLOIS DLC 55, SECTION 31, T 6 S, R 1 E, WM; 2350 FEET NORTH AND 2480 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER DLC 55.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

DOMESTIC AND 0.1 ACRE NE 1/4 SW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN LANGLOIS DLC 55
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 30724, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 6, 1967, approving transfer application B-178 and is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by the same order and supersedes certificate 30724.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
