CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. N. NICKERSON

of Rygh Valley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of White River, and Three Mile Creek, a tributary of White River
for the purpose of Irrigation Ch. Character of Use --- Sp. Div. Vol. 6 p 28

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 196; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902 for Tract #1, and 1916 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per
acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Para-
graph 24 of said decree);

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1.

Four and five tenths (4.5) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quar-
ter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Three and five tenths (3.5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the
Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and Eight (8) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the
Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Ten (10), Township Four (4) South, Range
Thirteen (13) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 16 acres.

Tract #2.

Sixteen acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of
Section Ten (10), Township Four (4) South, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Willa-
mette Meridian.

And said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
