CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that R. A. LINDSAY,  
of WILDERVILLE, OREGON 97543, has a right to the use of the waters of  
CHANAY CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF APPELEGATE RIVER, for the purpose of  
IRRIGATING 18.0 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the  
State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem,  
in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at  
page 1. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1884. The right is limited  
to not more than 0.302 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 18, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M.; LINDSAY  
DITCH.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such  
right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.0 ACRES NW1/4 SW1/4  
10.0 ACRES NE1/4 SW1/4  
SECTION 18  
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted  
to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be  
subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said  
decree.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed  
by certificate 16274, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT  
modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director  
entered FEBRUARY 18, 1988, approving transfer application 5979.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the  
status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610  
pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
