CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that ROBERT JOHNSON, of PRAIRIE CITY, OREGON 97869, has a right to the use of waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 4.0 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at page 461. The date of priority is 1870.

The right is limited to not more than 1/40 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE IRRIGATED FROM APRIL 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30; FURTHER LIMITED TO ONE ACRE FOOT PER ACRE PER CALENDAR MONTH TO JULY 1 AND THREE-QUARTERS ACRE FOOT PER ACRE THEREAFTER; TOTAL FIVE ACRE FEET PER ACRE FOR SEASON, MEASURED AT POINT OF DIVERSION.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 13 S, R 34 E, W.M.;
1920 FEET NORTH & 1060 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER SECTION 7.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4	1.8 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	1.5 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4	0.7 ACRE
SECTION 2	
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.	

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 27, 1972, and together with certificate 38303, supersedes certificate, 25526 State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
