CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that GREAT VALLEY DEVELOPMENT CO., of 6478 BLACKWELL ROAD, CENTRAL POINT, OREGON 97502, has a right to the use of waters of BEAR CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 10.3 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is JULY 30, 1901.

The right is limited to not more than 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 54, SECTION 27,
T 36 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 150 FEET NORTH AND 300 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER
SECTION 27.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 29, 1978, and together with certificate 47284, supersedes certificate, 15902 State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
