## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that LEONARD ORCHARDS COMPANY, of GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526, has a right to the use of the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 173.93 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 1155. The date of priority is APRIL 12, 1912. The right is limited to not more than 2.171 CUBIC FEET SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.
