CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that THOMAS V. AND CORA A. MOODY, of 2560 PLEASANT CREEK ROAD, ROGUE RIVER, OREGON 97537, has a right to the use of waters of PLEASANT CREEK, a tributary of EVANS CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.7 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1875.

The right is limited to not more than 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 33, T 34 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 2250 FEET SOUTH & 355 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 33.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.1 ACRE SECTION 33

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.6 ACRES SECTION 34 TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approve by an order of the Water Resources Director NOVEMBER 29, 1976, and together with certificates 44082, 47899, 47900, 47901, 47902, 57602, and 57603, supercedes certificate 40372, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture of abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
