CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that

LATTER DAY SAINTS CHURCH
of 2750 FOOTHILL ROAD MEDFORD, OR 97504
has a right to the use of the waters of SOUTH FORK LITTLE BUTTE
CREEK & NORTH FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF LITTLE BUTTE
CREEK
for the purpose of TEMPERATURE CONTROL.

The right to the use of these waters has been perfected
under Permit 39645. The date of priority is OCTOBER 22, 1974.
The right is limited to not more than 3.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND,
WATER TO BE DIVERTED FROM SOUTH FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK WHEN
AVAILABLE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM SOUTH
FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM NORTH *
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of
diversion from the source. The point of diversion is located as
follows:

(point 1) NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 29, T 36 S, R 02 E, WM;
600 FEET SOUTH & 525 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 29
(point 2) SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 20, T 36 S, R 02 E, WM;
70 FEET NORTH & 530 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 20

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system
as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to
which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK PROVIDED THAT THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED
FROM BOTH SOURCES SHALL NOT EXCEED 3.0 CFS.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is
restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water
Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
