CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that

of ROUTE 1 BOX 51A WALLOWA, OR 97885
has a right to the use of the waters of WALLOWA RIVER, TRIBUTARY OF
GRANDE RONDE RIVER
for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 18.5 ACRES AND STOCK.

The right to the use of these waters has been perfected
under Permit 39142. The date of priority is APRIL 11, 1974.
The right is limited to not more than 0.47 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND,
BEING 0.46 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.01 CFS FOR STOCK
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of
diversion from the source. The point of diversion is located as
follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 11, T 01 N, R 42 E, WM;
860 FEET NORTH & 800 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 11

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the
amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands,
shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per
acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further
limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for
each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system
as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to
which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Total:	18.50	acres.					

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is
restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water
Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
