CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that ARNOLD SANDWICK-TRUSTEE, of ROUTE 3, BOX 262, BEND, OREGON, has a right to the use of the waters of DESCHUTES RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 2.68 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 21807. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 30, 1952. The right is limited to not more than 0.067 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, T 17 S, R 12 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 1.33 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 1.35 ACRES
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.
