CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that ROBERT M. STOREY, of P.O. BOX 601, ROGUE RIVER, OREGON 97537, has a right to the use of waters of EVANS CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.5 ACRE AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 2.7 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523. The date of priority is 1902.

The right is limited to not more than 0.055 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION; VROMAN DITCH, SE 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 11, T 35 S, R 4 W, W.M.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 25, T 34 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 150 FEET SOUTH AND 240 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 25.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 6, 1983, and together with certificate 57707, 57709, 57710, supersedes certificate 32780, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
