CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That G. J. VAN DUYN

of Tygh Valley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Three Mile Creek, a tributary of White River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 196; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1878

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per
acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in
Paragraph 24 of said decree);

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

One (1) acre in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and
Sixteen and two tenths (16.2) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast
Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seven (7); Seventeen and eight tenths (17.8) acres
in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eight
(8), Township Four (4) South, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Willamette Merid-
ian, being a total of 35 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
