## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that MICHAEL E. HUGIE, of 5180 ROGUE RIVER DRIVE, EAGLE POINT, OREGON 97524, has a right to the use of the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 14.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 3687. The date of priority is OCTOBER 29, 1917. The right is limited to not more than 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 8 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4) LOT 7 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) SECTION 28, POD 1 200 FEET SOUTH AND 3250 FEET EAST; POD 2 - 1410 FEET SOUTH AND 3000 FEET EAST BOTH FROM NW CORNER SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
