that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre set per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 24 of said decree); and 0.5 second ft. for municipal purposes;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

One (1) acre in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NWANE4), Eleven (11) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE2NW4) and Three (5) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW2NW4) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Four (4) South, Range Twelve (12) East of The Willamette Meridian, being a total of 15 acres.
