CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That WAMIC WATER DITCH COMPANY

of Wamic, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Three Mile Creek, a tributary of White River for the purpose of Irrigation and Municipal

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 196; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1889

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 24 of said decree); and 0.5 second ft. for municipal purposes;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

One (1) acre in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), Eleven (11) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) and Three (3) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Four (4) South, Range Twelve (12) East of The Willamette Meridian, being a total of 15 acres.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
