CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that R. G. AND MARY ANNA BENNETT,
of 31010 PEACH COVE ROAD, WEST LINN, OREGON 97068, has a right to the
use of the waters of WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER,
for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 8.5 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 18840. The date of priority
is JULY 14, 1949. The right is limited to not more than 0.11 CUBIC
FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION; NE
1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22, T 3 S, R 1 E, W.M., or its equivalent in case
of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN G. BROCK DLC 46,
SECTION 22, T 3 S, R 1 E, W.M., BEING 3340 FEET NORTH & 2325 FEET EAST
FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER SECTION 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount
secured under any other right existing for the the same lands, shall
be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or
its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre
irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such
right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4	1.3 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	4.0 ACRES
NE 1/4 SE 1/4	2.3 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	0.9 ACRE

ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN G. BROCK DLC 46
SECTION 22
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION
approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered
FEBRUARY 13, 1978, and together with certificate 45473, supersedes
certificate 43545, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the
status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610
pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted
to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right
is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources
Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
