CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that IRVIN E. RAUCH, of LEXINGTON, OREGON 97839, has a right to the use of the waters of A WELL, IN THE WILLOW CREEK BASIN, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 4.52 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-1440. The date of priority is JUNE 24, 1954. The right is limited to not more than 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 18, T 1 N, R 26 E, W.M.; 250 FEET NORTH & 480 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER SECTION 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 6, 1978 and supersedes certificate 30193, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
