## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that ROBERT L. AND HELEN M. ATEN, of ROUTE 1, BOX 2012, BANDON, OREGON 97411, has a right to the use of the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of CROOKED CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 1.4 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 31372. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 21, 1966. The right is limited to not more than 0.035 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 17, T 29 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 430 FEET SOUTH AND 600 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER SECTION 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year FOR CRANBERRIES. IF FOR THE IRRIGATION OF ANY OTHER CROP, THIS APPROPRIATION SHALL BE LIMITED TO ONE-EIGHTIETH OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND OR ITS EQUIVALENT FOR EACH ACRE IRRIGATED AND SHALL BE FURTHER LIMITED TO A DIVERSION OF NOT TO EXCEED 2.5 ACRE FEET PER ACRE FOR EACH ACRE IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON OF EACH YEAR.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 44581, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on AUGUST 30, 1988, APPROVING TRANSFER APPLICATION NO. T-6079.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
