CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that DONALD A. AND MARGARET M. FULK, of 2385 HOLLAND LOOP ROAD, CAVE JUNCTION, OREGON 97523, has a right to the use of the waters of DEAD HORSE SLOUGH, A TRIBUTARY OF EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 4.2 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 41764. The date of priority is APRIL 28, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE1/4 NW1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40, SECTION 35, T39S, R8W, WM; 550 FEET SOUTH & 1930 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.2 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40  
LOT 6 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) 2.0 ACRES  
SECTION 35  
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
