CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that GEORGE W. OWENS, C/O MARQUARITE OWENS, of 8831 UPPER DEER CREEK, SELMA, OREGON 97538, has a right to the use of the waters of DEER CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 1.2 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 41138. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 30, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW1/4 SE1/4, SECTION 18, T38S, R6W, WM; 220 FEET SOUTH & 400 FEET EAST FROM CENTER SECTION 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.2 ACRES NW1/4 SE1/4
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
