CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that CLEO STOCKWELL, of ROUTE 1 BOX 187-F, CARLTON, OREGON 97111, has a right to the use of the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, AND A RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6518 TRIBUTARY OF PANTHER CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 2.3 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 40839. The date of priority is JULY 20, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE1/4 SW1/4, SECTION 24, T3S, R5W, WM; 360 FEET NORTH & 1790 FEET EAST; 150 FEET NORTH & 1870 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 ACRES SE1/4 SW1/4  
SECTION 24

0.3 ACRE NE1/4 NW1/4  
SECTION 25  
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
