CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE, of P.O. BOX 3503, PORTLAND, OREGON 97208, has a right to the use of the waters of CEDAR CREEK AND CEDAR CREEK REARING PONDS 12 & 13 CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7776 for the purpose of FISH REARING.

The right has been perfected under Permit 43814. The date of priority is MARCH 15, 1974. The right is limited to not more than 30.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND; BEING 8.2 CFS FROM CEDAR CREEK AND POND 12 AND 21.8 CFS FROM CEDAR CREEK AND POND 13 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NW1/4 NW1/4), SECTION 19, T4S, R9W, W.M.;
100 FEET SOUTH & 300 FEET EAST, 250 FEET SOUTH & 300 FEET EAST, BOTH
FROM NW CORNER SECTION 19.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 1 (NW1/4 NW1/4)
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
