CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that KENNETH HUNT, of 5200 4-H CENTER ROAD NW, SALEM, OREGON 97304, has a right to the use of the waters of TWO SPRINGS, TRIBUTARIES OF SPRING VALLEY CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY, STOCK AND IRRIGATING 0.4 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 41322. The date of priority is JANUARY 4, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.001 CFS FOR STOCK AND 0.005 CFS FOR IRRIGATION FROM SPRING 1, AND 0.004 CFS FROM SPRING 2 FOR DOMESTIC USE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW1/4 NE1/4, SECTION 2, T7S, R4W, W.M.; SPRING 1-430 FEET SOUTH & 1340 FEET WEST; SPRING 2 - 560 FEET SOUTH & 1400 FEET WEST; BOTH FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 1 (NE1/4 NE1/4) 0.4 ACRE, STOCK & DOMESTIC SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
