CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MILLER FORESTS P.O. BOX 12395 SALEM, OREGON 97309

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the CLAGGETT CREEK BASIN for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 26.1 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-7306. The date of priority is MARCH 9, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.33 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well. The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 69, SECTION 27, T 6 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1500 FEET NORTH & 700 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER OF DLC 69.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 8.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 6.2 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 5.5 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 6.0 ACRES
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 69
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
