CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN V. CAROTHERS

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAR CREEK, a tributary of LONG TOM RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 8.3 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 25525. The date of priority is MAY 2, 1958. The right is limited to not more than 0.1 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION; NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 34, T 15 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 2500 FEET NORTH AND 1580 FEET EAST FROM THE S1/4 CORNER SECTION 34, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 34, T 15 S, R 5 W, W.M.;
1140 FEET NORTH & 390 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER SECTION 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

W 1/2 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 8.1 ACRES
W 1/2 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.2 ACRE
SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 12, 1979, and together with certificate 47737, supersedes certificate 29378, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
