CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of YAMHILL RIVER IN HAKOLA RESERVOIR, APPROPRIATED UNDER PERMIT 45642, for the purpose of FISH CULTURE.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-8251. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1981. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 3.9 ACRE-FEET.

The reservoir is located as follows:

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
