CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DON HAKOLA
ROUTE 2, BOX 294
DAYTON, OREGON 97114

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND HAKOLA RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8251, TRIBUTARY TO YAMHILL RIVER, for the purpose of FISH CULTURE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45642. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 44, SECTION 17,
T 4 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 500 FEET SOUTH AND 2170 FEET WEST FROM THE NE
CORNER SECTION 17.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 44
SECTION 17
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
