confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED GULCH AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8519, tributary of APPLEGATE RIVER, for the purpose of MAINTENANCE OF A RESERVOIR FOR RECREATIONAL FISHING AND LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47093. The date of priority is JUNE 23, 1981, FOR 0.03 CFS AND JUNE 20, 1982, FOR 0.0012 CFS. The right is limited to not more than 0.0312 cubic foot per second, BEING 0.03 CFS FOR MAINTENENCE OF A RESERVOIR FOR RECREATIONAL FISHING AND 0.0012 CFS FOR LIVESTOCK or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 38 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 2680 FEET NORTH & 1540 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 21.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
NW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
