CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL IN THE THOMAS CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 224.4 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-8194. The date of priority is OCTOBER 14, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 2.30 cubic feet per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well. The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 24, T 38 S, R 19 E, W.M.;
1220 FEET SOUTH & 1100 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4	32.5 ACRES
NW 1/4 NW 1/4	33.3 ACRES
SW 1/4 NW 1/4	39.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	39.8 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4	39.5 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4	39.8 ACRES

SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
