CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

24011 EAST EVANS CREEK ROAD
WHITE CITY, OREGON 97501

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK EVANS CREEK, a tributary of EVANS CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE IN AREA.

The right has been perfected under Permit 36017. The date of priority is MARCH 8, 1971. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 cubic FOOT per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 33 S, R 2 W, W.M.;
160 FEET NORTH & 250 FEET WEST FROM CENTER SECTION 33.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
