CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JOE ALMADA

of Durkee, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Burnt River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 134; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1872 for Tract #1; March 18, 1877 for Tract #2;
Aug. 6, 1877 for Tract #3;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet
per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained
in Paragraph 64 of said decree);

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1.

Three (3) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of
Section Thirty (30), Township Eleven (11) South, Range Forty-three (43) East of
the Willamette Meridian.

Tract #2.

Thirteen (13) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
of Section Nineteen (19); Five (5) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the North-
east Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and Seventeen (17) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the
Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30), Township Eleven (11) South,
Range Forty-three (43) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 35 acres.

Tract #3.

Sixteen (16) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$),
Fourteen (14) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$),
Thirteen (13) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
and Eleven (11) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
of Section Thirty (30), Township Eleven (11) South, Range Forty-three (43) East
of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 54 acres.

(NOTE: 5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 1 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ also irrigated through Powers Ditch
and branch of Banks Ditch under date of 1913).

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
