CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT  
P.O. BOX 700, VALE OREGON 97918  
confirms the right to store the waters of BLACK WILLOW GULCH  
a tributary of OWYHEE RIVER , for the purpose of LIVESTOCK AND  
WILDLIFE.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under  
Reservoir permit R- 4442. The date of priority is 2/21/1964.

The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right  
is not more than 1.11 ACRE-FEET.

The reservoir is located as follows:

NE1/4 NE1/4  
SECTION 12  
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and  
maintenance of an outlet pipe or to provide other means to evacuate the  
stored water when determined by the Water Resources Director to satisfy  
prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is  
restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
