CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That BURNT RIVER DREDGING COMPANY

of Portland, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Burnt River, Cave Creek, Deer Creek for the purpose of Irrigation and Mining

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 134; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1879

That the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 64 of said decree); and ten cubic feet per second for mining purposes;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Five (5) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE 1/4 SE 1/4); Thirty (30) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4 SE 1/4), of Section Thirty-one (31), Twenty (20) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) of Section Thirty-two (32), Township Eleven (11), South, Range Forty-two (42) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 55 acres.

(Place of use in mining on NW 1/4 NE 1/4, E 1/2 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 32 T. 11 S. R. 42 E. W. M., method of use is by pumping.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
