confirms the right to store the waters of AN INTERMITTENT STREAM, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for the purpose of STORAGE RESERVOIR #2 AND #3 FOR FISH CULTURE.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-6377. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1974. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 1.8 ACRE FEET, BEING 0.2 AF IN RESERVOIR #2 AND 1.6 AF IN RESERVOIR #3.

The reservoirs are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
SECTION 2  
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
