CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to store the waters of WALLOWA RIVER, a tributary of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, IN WALLOWA WILDLIFE GRAVEL PIT RESERVOIR, APPROPRIATED UNDER PERMIT 40313, for the purpose of RECREATION.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-6422. The date of priority is APRIL 22, 1975, FOR 10.0 ACRE-FEET AND AUGUST 28, 1975, FOR 2.4 ACRE-FEET. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 12.4 ACRE-FEET.

The reservoir is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 42 EAST, W.M.

The dam is to be operated and maintained in accordance with the approved plans and specifications on file with the Water Resources Department.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
