has a right to the use of the waters of WALLOWA RIVER AND WALLOWA WILDLIFE GRAVEL PIT RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6422 for the purpose of RECREATION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 40313. The date of priority is APRIL 22, 1975. The right is limited to not more than 0.1 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 3, T 1 N, R 42 E, W.M.; 1600 FEET NORTH & 660 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 3.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 4 TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 42 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
