that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1.

Forty (40) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NEINW2), Forty (40) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW2NW2), Forty (40) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW2NW2), Sixteen (16) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE2NW2), Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Twelve (12) South, Range Thirty-eight (38) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 136 acres.

Gract #2.

Twelve (12) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE1NW1) Section Twenty-nine (29), Twomship Twelve (12) South, Range Thirty-eight (38) East of the Willamette Meridian.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
