confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND WILEY RESERVOIR NO. 7 CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7995, a tributary of WEST FORK MOSIER CREEK, for the purpose of FISH CULTURE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44674. The date of priority is OCTOBER 6, 1978. The right is limited to not more than 0.23 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 36, T 2 N, R 11 E, W.M.; 170 FEET NORTH & 630 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 36.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
