CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING AND UMPQUA RIVER, tributaries of THE PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of STOCK AND IRRIGATING 0.5 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 39319. The date of priority is DECEMBER 30, 1974. The right is limited to not more than 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FROM THE SPRING FOR STOCK AND 0.01 CFS FROM THE RIVER FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOT 2 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 6, LOT 9 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 7, T 25 S, R 7 W, W.M.; RIVER - 75 FEET NORTH & 515 FEET WEST; SPRING - 765 FEET SOUTH & 680 FEET WEST BOTH FROM THE N1/4 CORNER SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 9 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) 0.5 ACRE AND STOCK
SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
