CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to store the waters of BIRCH CREEK
a tributary of OWYHEE RIVER , for the purpose of LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under
Reservoir permit R-2951. The date of priority is AUGUST 8, 1961.

The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right
is not more than 3.30 ACRE-FEET.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SW1/4 NW1/4
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 43 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and
maintenance of an outlet pipe or to provide other means to evacuate the
stored water when determined by the Water Resources Director to satisfy
prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is
restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
