CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WAYNE FISK  
27400 SOUTH GRIBBLE ROAD

confirms the right to use the waters of GRIBBLE CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6661, a tributary of MOLALLA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 42013. The date of priority is AUGUST 16, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 38, SECTION 21, T 4 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 1020 FEET NORTH & 650 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER DLC 38.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year FROM DIRECT FLOW AND STORAGE FROM THE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6661.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.0 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 38  
SECTION 21  
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
