confirms the right to store the waters of WILLOW CREEK, a tributary TO BEAVERTON CREEK, IN HARTUNG LAKE RESERVOIR, APPROPRIATED UNDER PERMIT 41552, for the purpose of RECREATION.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-6582. The date of priority is MAY 5, 1977. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 24.6 ACRE-FEET.

The reservoir is located as follows:

LOT 3 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)
NE 1/4 SW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 55
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The dam is to be operated and maintained in accordance with the approved plans and specifications on file with the Water Resources Department.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
