CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK AND HARTUNG LAKE RESERVOIR, ENLARGED UNDER PERMIT R-6582, a tributary of BEAVERTON CREEK, for the purpose of RECREATION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 41552. The date of priority is MAY 5, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.3 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 3 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 28, T 1 N, R 1 W, W.M.;
1760 FEET NORTH & 1320 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 28.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 3 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)
NE 1/4 SW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 55
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
