confirms the right to store the waters of CLEARY CREEK, a tributary of COYOTE CREEK IN CLEARY CREEK RESERVOIR, APPROPRIATED UNDER PERMIT 47242 AS AMENDED AUGUST 16, 1988, BY SPECIAL ORDER RECORDED IN VOLUME 42 AT PAGES 341 & 342, for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-8548. The date of priority is APRIL 30, 1979. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 30.0 ACRE-FEET.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 35  
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

CLEARY CREEK DIVERSION LOCATED: NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 35, T 17 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 2430 FEET NORTH & 1960 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER SECTION 35.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
