The right has been perfected under Permit 44309. The date of priority is APRIL 30, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, T 4 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 2320 FEET SOUTH & 630 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 14.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
