CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CITY OF DUFUR

of Dufur, State of Oregon; has a right to the ^{exclusive} use of

the waters of Eleven springs located in Sections 23, 27, 28, 32 and 33, T. 2 S. R. 11 E.W.M.

for the purpose of Municipal Use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from Dec. 28, 1905

~~that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed~~

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Within the City of Dufur,
Oregon.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
