confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of IMNAHA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN AND STOCK USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44528. The date of priority is JULY 26, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.005 CFS FOR LIVESTOCK or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 35, T 1 S, R 48 E, W.M.; 1360 FEET SOUTH & 2840 FEET WEST NE COFNER SECTION 35.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 35 TOWNSHIP 1 SCUTH, RANGE 48 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
