confirms the right to use the waters of GALES CREEK, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN OR NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT EXCEEDING 1/2 ACRE IN AREA, PROVIED THAT WATER SHALL NOT BE APPROPRIATED DURING THE PERIOD FROM JULY 31 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR, EXCEPT FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44736. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 21, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60, SECTION 8, T 1 N, R 4 W, W.M.; 650 FEET SOUTH & 1260 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER SECTION 8.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60
SECTION 8
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
